



Blind Eye 2020 Cabernet Sauvignon - Napa Valley

The brilliant and audacious Admiral Lord Nelson held the telescope to his blind eye and claimed not to see the signal to retreat. He won the battle.

Our flagship Napa Valley Cabemet Sauvignon is a classic representation of the appellation's preeminent varietal. Notes of black cherry, blackberry and plum are complemented by hits of toasted oak, dried currant and baking spice. Fine-grained tannins and ample brightness on the palate give way to a polished mouthfeel and exceptionally long finish.



Blind Eye

2018 Cabernet Sauvignon - Mount Veeder, Napa Valley

The brilliant and audacious Admiral Lord Nelson held the telescope to his blind eye and claimed not to see the signal to retreat. He won the battle.

Crafted from a ridgetop vineyard on Mount Veeder, our Blind Eye 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon reflects the essence of its terroir. The long, cool 2018 season allowed for extended hangtime, resulting in a wine of remarkable structure and balance. Aromas of cassis, black cherry, and lingonberry intertwine with nuances of crushed cocoa, violets, and thyme. Silky tannins complement the complex fruit profile, leading to a lingering finish of black tea and kirsch.



Dead Reckoning

2021 Pinot Noir - Russian River Valley, Sonoma County

While respecting the precision of modern navigation, mariners of old used the Method of dead reckoning. By taking the time spent on each heading and at each speed they could calculate the route and distance the ship had covered and mark a sea chart. For all the precision of modern winemaking, sometimes there's no substitute for the tried-and-true art of dead reckoning.

From the Russian River Valley AVA of Sonoma County, this beautiful wine is influenced mostly by the fog of the AVA and is very aromatic, with a velvet mouthfeel, and has a fruit character that is ripe and intense.





Cut & Run 2019 Red Wine - Napa Valley

Sometimes you need to set sail urgently and should cut free the anchor or sever the ropes that unfurl the sails. There is always a time and place to cut and run.

This 2019 Red Wine is an artful red blend created by winemaker Todd Heth. This wine exhibits dark blackberry, bing cherry and plum notes perfectly into layers of coffee and tobacco. The finish is dry with long lasting berry fruit. Silky but firm tannins, this wine is enjoyable now but has the ability to age well in the cellar.



Mainstay 2019 Zinfandel - Calistoga, Napa Valley

The mainstay is a large, strong sheet (rope) that holds the main mast of a ship forward. It is so critical that now it also means someone or something that provides support for a thing to exist or succeed.

Our Mainstay 2019 Zinfandel from Calistoga showcases the bold character of its appellation. Bursting with ripe berry flavors, this Zinfandel offers notes of blackberry and raspberry layered with hints of baking spices and a touch of vanilla. The wine's robust structure is balanced by a velvety texture, culminating in a rich, lingering finish.



Cat o' Nine Tails 2019 Sauvignon Blanc - Napa Valley

The cat-o'-nine-tails was made up of nine pieces of knotted cord fixed on a thick piece of rope as a handle. It was used as an authorized instrument of punishment in the British Navy until 1881. This wine is called cat-o'-nine-tails because it resisted all our attempts to discipline it.

Cat o' Nine Tails 2019 Sauvignon Blanc captures the vibrant essence of Napa Valley. Aromas of fresh-cut grass and tropical fruits lead into flavors of guava, passionfruit, and ripe melon. Crisp acidity and a hint of minerality add to the wine's refreshing character, making it an ideal companion for warm days.





Stem to Stern 2021 White Wine - Calistoga, Napa Valley

The description "stem to stern" means the entire ship. You can also use this phrase as an expression for all-inclusive, or very thorough.

Stem to Stem 2021 White Wine is a harmonious blend that epitomizes Calistoga's elegance. Delicate aromas of white flowers and ripe lemon precede flavors of tropical fruits, including pineapple and mango. Subtle hints of vanilla and white pepper enhance the wine's complexity, while a bright, zesty finish leaves a lasting impression.



Fathom 2020 Chardonnay - Russian River Valley, Sonoma County

Although a fathom is now a nautical unit of length equal to six feet, it was once defined by an act of Parliament as "the length of a man's arms around the object of his affections." The word derives from the Old English Faethm, which means "embracing arms."

Hailing from the cool and foggy climate for the Russian River Valley in Sonoma County, this beautiful medium-bodied wine was grown slowly to build intense flavors over time. This wine was aged in French oak and displays a beautiful balance of fruit, oak and liveliness on the palate and exhibits lush mango and toasted almond. Balanced fruit with tarte acidity makes this wine a classic example of Premium Russian River Chardonnay.



Charlie Noble 2018 Blanc de Blancs - Napa Valley

Charlie Noble is an "it," not a "he." A British merchant service captain, Charles Noble, is said to be responsible for the origin, about 1850, of this nickname for the galley smokestack. It seems that Captain Noble, discovering that the stack of his ship's galley was made of copper, ordered that it be kept bright. The ship's crew then started referring to the stack as the "Charlie Noble."

This premium sparkling wine — meticulously and artfully made in the traditional champagne method is blended superbly from 100% Chardonnay. This magnificent Napa Valley Blanc de Blancs exhibits beautiful green apple and tropical notes in the aroma follow through in the mouth with a smooth fine mousse. This wine finishes with refreshing, lingering light tropical flavors that beg for another sip.





Rosé of Cabernet 2021 Rosé - Russian River Valley, Sonoma County

Our Rose of Cabernet 2021 hails from the Russian River Valley, offering a delightful expression of Cabernet Sauvignon in rosé form. Vibrant aromas of fresh strawberries and watermelon precede flavors of red berries and citrus zest. A crisp acidity and a hint of floral notes on the finish make this rosé a perfect companion for sunny days.



Rosé of Cabernet 2022 Rosé - Napa Valley
